- ❖ The CBSE results are the true testimony to the academic brilliance of a school. As Thomas Edison said Genius is one percent inspiration and 99 percent perspiration. It is true for the board result too. The results mirror the hardwork of students and the tireless guidance and mentoring of the teachers motivated by the Principal Director and Vice Principal. The second batch of class X took the board examination in March 2022. The result was superlative. Raghav Agrawal Topped the school list with 97.8% scoring 100 out of 100 in mathematics and 99 out of 100 in English. Bhavik Jain Topped second scoring 97.4% with 100 out of 100 in mathematics. He was followed by Harit Chanchani in the third position securing 94.4%.
 - ❖ Out of 56 students who took the boards 5 children secured above 90 %, 17 students secured above 80% and 15 students secured above 70% in aggregate. A huge round of applause for all these achievers.
